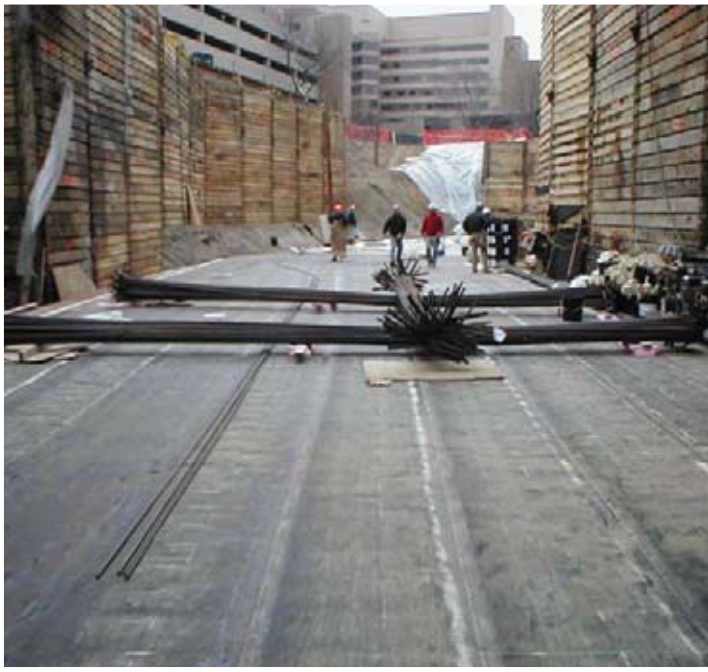

Project Description

Ram Building Restoration & Waterproofing was the preferred subcontractor to waterproof a new biomedical center building at the Ohio State University. Working with cutting-edge materials, the Ram Building Restoration & Waterproofing crew installed Laurenco Membrane waterproofing under 67,000 sq. ft. of foundation mat, on 32,000 sq. ft. of wall, 63,000 sq. ft. of plaza and tunnel tops, and on 25,000 sq. ft. of split slab mechanical floors. Unique challenges were presented by an unusually high groundwater table, working around multiple subcontractors, a very tight construction schedule and intensive scrutiny by the membrane manufacturer for warranty compliance.
