Project Description

The parapet on the historic School of Education building at the University of Michigan was removed and rebuilt. The University stipulated that the restored parapet must match the original in appearance. The existing face brick had to be removed, cleaned and re-used. Also, Western Waterproofing matched the lime mortar used on the building facade to maintain its original appearance. Coordination and speed were essential to minimize interference with the operation of the building.
